MAPPM is a programme that focuses on the study of Public Management. This programme's scope is similar to the discipline of Public Management (1252) specified by the Mainland authority, as indicated in their official website.

Upon successful completion of the programme, you should be able to:



Discover and analyse critically current and emerging knowledge relating to principles, theories and practices in international and local governance, public policy and management

Contrast and assess the roles, inter-relationships and limitations of various actors and organisations involved in the governance of people, and money, environment

Be creative in problem solving and demonstrate practical and, appropriate, innovative management, planning, team-working, decision making and research skills

Contribute to the development of knowledge about public policy and management by active discovery through undertaking supervised dissertation, capstone project, or other project-related coursework

Explain, compare and evaluate critically various values, ethical principles and cultural traditions shaping policy-making processes and the delivery of services to the community

Enhance their theoretical knowledge and to discover new insights into public policy and making management in both local and international contexts

Develop their intellectual capacity and analytical skills by doing applied research on the effective and efficient utilization of public resources for the betterment of society

Hone practical skills required for effective public management and to strenathen their abilities contribute to creative and innovative problem solving in public policy and management contexts

Scholarships

The PIA Entrance Scholarships for International Postgraduate Students of MAPPM

International students (excluding those from Greater China Region, i.e., Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan) may receive entrance scholarships of up to HK\$100,000 based on outstanding entrance academic performance and financial need.

Hong Kong Future Talents Scholarship (FTSS)

The Government has launched the FTSS for meritorious local students admitted to the Master's Programmes in priority areas.



MAPPM is identified as one of the programmes.

Outstanding local students may receive the FTSS covering up to HK\$100,000 of tuition fees.
